Our Mission:

Touchstone Golf Foundation is a non-profit 501(c)(3) organization dedicated to improving our communities through service, education, and charitable efforts by raising funds through golf related activities, and by promoting the enjoyment of and the values learned through the game of golf.

Volunteer Expectations:

Volunteers are expected to be available for 1-3 volunteer shifts at the course each week, plus 30 hours of additional community service outside normal course activities per year. Because Volunteers utilize golf carts during their activities, and interact with guests and course employees, each must have a valid driver license, a safe driving record, and will be subject to substance abuse screening and a background check.

On course Volunteer activities include greeting and assisting visitors/players to the golf course, providing advice to further understanding and appreciation of the game of golf, helping to maintain pace of play, raising funds for charitable, scientific, or educational purposes, and other tasks consistent with the Mission and vision of the Touchstone Golf Foundation.

For further information, please refer to the Touchstone Golf Foundation Volunteer Expectations document, which volunteers will be required to sign prior to beginning an assignment with TGF.

Golfing Privileges and other Benefits:

Golf related privileges and other benefits are provided to enhance your ability to remain engaged in the game of golf and with your host course and constituents as you perform charitable activities. These benefits may change from time to time at the sole discretion of the host property. Your host course currently provides access to the following benefits: Free green fees and discounted shared cart fee anytime on weekdays and Weekends/Holidays after 1pm on a space available basis and subject to business needs; 50% off meals and non-alcoholic beverages during volunteer shift, one free bucket of range balls per volunteer shift, 10% discount on merchandise. *(Tee time reservations may be permitted by the General Manager at off-peak times. However, times may be moved without notice based on demand for paying guests. All tee times subject to availability.)*
